OUR ELK RANCH HAS BEEN UNDER ONE OWNERSHIP FOR THE PAST 63 YEARS! DURING THAT TIME IT HAS RECEIVED MINIMAL HUNTING PRESSURE AND HAS CERTAINLY DEVELOPED INTO A PREMIER PROPERTY FOR HUNTING BIG ELK. BULLS GENERALLY RANGE BETWEEN 320"-350", BUT LARGER BULLS HAVE BEEN HARVESTED AND MANY MORE SEEN. THE RANCH'S FUNDAMENTAL SUCCESS STEMS FROM A LARGE POPULATION OF COWS THAT OCCUPY THE RANCH THROUGHOUT THE YEAR. WHEN AUGUST ROLLS AROUND BULLS BEGIN TO TRANSITION FROM THE HIGHER. COOLER BASINS TO THE LOWER MEADOWS TO PREPARE FOR THE RUT. WITH A RESIDENT HERD OF 200-300 COWS, IT'S ONLY A MATTER OF TIME BEFORE BIG BULLS MAKE THERE WAY TO THE RANCH.
